Itinerary

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN MANILA

- Arrive in Manila, meet and greet
- Transfer to hotel for check-in
- Overnight accommodation at Kingsford Hotel Manila (4*)

DAY 2 MANILA / CITY TOUR (B)

- Breakfast inside the hotel

Proceed to:

HALF DAY MANILA CITY TOUR

- The tour starts right in the heart of Philippines's financial district, the City of Makati. Have a glimpse of Makati's hustle and bustle as you drive through on your way to the capital city, Manila. Onwards Rizal Park on scenic Roxas Boulevard, arrive in Intramuros, "The Walled City", to see ancient walls, church ruins and relics from Spain's Conquistadores.
- Sites to visit: American War Cemetery, Rizal Park, Fort Santiago, San Agustin and Manila Cathedral, running tour at Cultural Center Complex along Roxas Boulevard if time permitting.
- After the tour, transfer back to hotel
- Rest of the time is free at leisure
- Lunch and dinner on personal account
- Overnight accommodation at Kingsford Hotel Manila (4*)

DAY 3 MANILA | BANAUE VIA CAUAYAN, ISABELA BY FLIGHT (B)

- Packed breakfast (by the hotel, to be confirmed)
- Checked-out hotel and proceed to Manila Domestic Airport
- **0530H** Check-in at Manila Domestic Airport
- **0635H** Depart Manila for Cauayan, Isabela via Cebu Pacific
- **0745H** Arrival in Cauayan, Isabela
- Travel by land to Banaue (traveling time is approximately 4 hours)
- **1200H** Time of arrival in Banaue
- Check-in at hotel
- Overnight accommodation at Banaue Hotel (4*)

BANAUE | HAPAO VILLAGE RICE TERRACES

- **1400H** Depart Banaue Hotel, using local non air-conditioned jeepney to visit the picturesque town of Hapao where you will view the Banaue rice terraces, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- The terraces are just a few of extensive stoned-walled terraces built centuries ago. It is believed that it is in this place where the origin of the terraces culture of the ifugao's started. It is located 9 kms. from Poblacion, Hungduan and 17 kms. northwest of Banaue.
- Back to the hotel late in the afternoon
- Overnight accommodation at Banaue Hotel (4*)

DAY 4 BANAUE | BONTOC | SAGADA | VIGAN (B)

- Breakfast inside the hotel
- **0700H** After breakfast, check-out hotel and depart for Sagada. Visit the Bontoc Museum, founded by a Belgian Sister, which houses a varied collection of authentic artifacts and photos from the mountain tribes.
- **0900H** Visit the picturesque town of Sagada, stop and see their ancient burial caves with mummified coffins.
- **1200H** Lunch at a local restaurant in Bontoc or Sagada (on personal account)
- **1300H** After lunch, depart Sagada for Vigan, Ilocos Sur via Cervantes – Tagudin Road (traveling time is approximately 4 – 5 hours by land travel)
- **1800H** Time of arrival in Vigan. Welcome to Vigan, Ilocos Sur! In Ilocos Sur, you will be delighted to step into the picturesque Vigan, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It feels like time travelling to the past, as the Spanish-era house have been well-preserved over the years. Check-in at hotel
- Overnight accommodation at Hotel Luna (4*)

DAY 5 VIGAN | HERITAGE TOUR (B)

- Breakfast inside the hotel
- 0700H Check out hotel and depart for Vigan Heritage Tour

VIGAN HERITAGE TOUR

- Spanish-era mansions, cobblestone streets and Kalesa (horse drawn carriage) are the hallmarks of historic Vigan. Miraculously spared by bombing in WWII, Vigan was designated a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE.
- Sights to visit: Archbishop's Palace, St. Paul's Cathedral, Mestizo District, Padre Jose Burgos National Museum, Pottery Factories or Pagburnayan Jar Making
- Lunch at a local restaurant (on personal account)
- Continuation of the tour
- Back to hotel in the afternoon
- Overnight accommodation at Hotel Luna (4*)

DAY 6 VIGAN | LAOAG CITY TOUR | FLIGHT BACK TO MANILA (B)

- Breakfast inside the hotel
- 0700H Check-out hotel and proceed to Laoag

LAOAG CITY TOUR

- Long before Laoag was established in 1580 with St. William the hermit as its patron Saint, Chinese and Japanese merchants visited the area, which was renowned for its gold mine. Laoag eventually became the capital of Ilocos Norte and Loyal Marcos Country.
- Sights as follows:
- St. Williams Cathedral, Paoay Church, Malacanang of the North
- **1300H** After the tour, proceed to Laoag International Airport



- **1425H** Departure in Laoag for Manila
- **1535H** Time of arrival in Manila, meet and greet
- Transfer to hotel for check-in
- Overnight accommodation at Kingsford Hotel Manila (4*)

DAY 7 DEPARTURE IN MANILA (B)

- Breakfast inside the hotel
- Check-out and transfer to NAIA
