

# Jordan Cultural Program - 2024 11 Nights / 12 Days



## DAY 1 // ARRIVAL AMMAN

Airport pick up from Queen Alia International Airport with Meet & Assist service through our representative, transfer to Amman hotel for check in. Overnight stay in Amman (as per flight time)

#### DAY 2 // AMMAN - AMMAN CITY TOUR - DESERT CASTEL - AMMAN

After breakfast, start Tour the downtown part of capital city Amman for 2 hours, visiting sites and museums including the Archeological Museum, the Folklore Museum, The citadel, and the Amphitheatre. Everywhere you look there is evidence of the city's much older past (Museums are closed on Tuesday), Proceed to the Eastern Desert to visit Al Kharraneh Castle, Amra Castle (a UNESCO World Heritage site), and Al Azraq Castle where Lawrence of Arabia resided and wrote part of his book "Seven Pillars of Wisdom". Overnight stay in Amman (B)



## DAY 3 // AMMAN - JERASH - AJLOUN - AMMAN

After breakfast, we head to visit the ancient Roman city of Jerash, including the paved and colonnaded streets, soaring hilltop temples, theatres, spacious public squares and plazas, baths, fountains and city walls. Proceeding to northern Jordan to visit one of the most important ecological and historical sites in the Middle East; Ajloun. Ajloun Castle (Qal'at ArRabad) is a fine example of Islamic architecture as it was built by Saladin's general in 1184 AD to control the iron mines of Ajloun, and to counter the progress of the Crusaders by dominating the three main routes leading to the Jordan valley and protecting the communication routes between Jordan and Syria. Overnight stay in Amman (B)

#### DAY 4 // AMMAN - PELLA - UM QAIS - AMMAN

After breakfast, Transfer to visit Pella where you can see the remains of a Chalcolthic settlement the 4th millennium BC, Byzantine churches and houses and a small medieval mosque. Proceed to Um Qais, previously known as Gadara, a city renowned as the site of the famous miracle of the Gadarene swine, a cultural center in its time and the home to several classical poets and philosophers Promenade through Um Qais and see its colonnaded street, vaulted terrace and the ruins of two theatres., back to Amman Overnight stay in Amman (B)

#### DAY 5 // AMMAN - MADABA - MOUNT NEBO - KERAK CASTLE - PETRA

After breakfast, depart to Wadi Musa City via kings high way visiting Madaba, Mount Nebo and Kerak Castle en route, arrive to Petra for check in, overnight in Petra Hotel Madaba, a city best known for the famous 6th century Mosaic map of Jerusalem & Holy Land and for its spectacular Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics and visit of St. George's church, Mount Nebo - Moses Mountain, situated 10 kilometers west of Madaba, overlooking the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea, West Bank and Jerusalem, where believed the alleged sites of the tomb of Moses.,Last stop is Kerak Castle is a Crusaders' Castle built on a triangular plateau dating back to the 12th century. Overnight stay in Petra (B)



## DAY 6 // PETRA - PETRA VISIT - PETRA

After breakfast, Visit the Nabatean Red Rose city of Petra, one of the 7 world wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enter the city through 1KM long narrow gorge which is flanked either side by 80m high cliffs! Notice the dazzling colors and formations of the rocks. The site is massive, and contains hundreds of elaborated rock-cut tombs, a treasury, Romanstyle theatres, temples, sacrificial altars and colonnaded streets. Overnight stay in Petra (B)

# DAY 7 // PETRA - LITTLE PETRA - WADI RUM JEEP TOUR - WADI RUM

After breakfast, proceed to visit Little Petra best known as Al Beidha (the White One) due to the pale rock colors. Little Petra, also known as Siq al-Barid (literally "the cold canyon") is an archaeological site located north of Petra and the town of Wadi Musa in, it is a Nabataean site, with buildings carved into the walls of the sandstone canyons. As its name suggests, it is much smaller, consisting of three wider open areas connected by a 450-metre (1,480 ft) canyon. It is part of the Petra Archeological Park, though accessed separately, We head further down in southern Jordan to visit other significant sites including Wadi Rum. Explore Wadi Rum on a 2 hour jeep ride into the Jordanian desert! Wadi Rum was best described by T.E. Lawrence as "Vast, echoing and god-like", and by the locals as "Valley of the Moon" Dinner & Overnight stay in Wadi Rum (HB)

#### DAY 8 // WADI RUM – AQABA RED SEA GLASS BOTTOM BOAT TRIP – AQABA

After breakfast, morning transfer to Aqaba City for a day of leisure and relaxation. Jordan's splendid Red Sea resort has a wealth of other attractions apart from being a delightful beach retreat; it is actually a great base from which to explore various places of interest in southern Jordan. we will enjoy Glass Bottom Boat Trip for 2 hours which will include 1 hour coral viewing and 1 hour snorkeling, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure Overnight stay in Aqaba (B)

#### DAY 9 // AQABA – FREE DAY

Kick back and relax in your free day in Agaba (No Vehicle) Overnight stay in Agaba (B)



## DAY 10 // AQABA - BETHANY - DEAD SEA

After breakfast, depart to Dead Sea, en route we will make a stop at The baptismal site of Jesus Christ (Bethany beyond Jordan).where John the Baptist prepared the way for the arrival of the Messiah, and John's ministry itself marked the beginning of the preaching of "the gospel of the Kingdom of God" (Luke 16:16). Some of the pivotal events in John's life and his heralding of the coming of Jesus took place in Jordan. Though Jesus Christ's divinely inspired role was announced before and during His birth, He launched His public ministry at Bethany beyond the Jordan at age 30, immediately after He was baptized by John and anointed by God (Luke 3:21-23, Acts 1:21-22). Overnight stay in Dead Sea (B)

#### DAY 11 // DEAD SEA - FREE DAY

Kick back and relax in your Dead Sea Resort; . It is the lowest body of water on earth, the lowest point on earth, and the world's richest source of natural salts, hiding wonderful treasures that accumulated throughout thousands of years. Overnight in Dead Sea (B)
