09 NIGHTS // 10 DAYS



DAY 01: ARRIVAL TRANSFER

Arrive at Muscat International Airport, meet and greet by our representative at the arrival area and transfer to your hotel and check-in. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Muscat (No Meal)

DAY 02: MUSCAT- NAKHAL - WAKAN

Breakfast in Hotel. At 08:00 AM, begin your journey to Nakhal, driving through scenic date palm groves. Visit the historic Nakhal Fort, perched above the old village. After exploring the fort, continue to the nearby Nakhal Hot Springs. Nestled at the edge of a lush oasis, the warm, shallow waters provide a serene setting for relaxation amidst green plantations and rugged mountains. Later head to Wakan village, situated 2,000 meters above sea level in the Western Hajar Mountains. Known for its terraced gardens and panoramic views over Wadi Mistal, this small mountain village offers natural beauty and tranquility. Embark on a moderate 4–5-hour hike between Koor Bilad and Hadash Bilad, enjoying breathtaking vistas and cool mountain air throughout the trek. Overnight stay at Sama Heritage Home Wakhan (Breakfast & Dinner)

DAY 03: WAHAN – WADI BANI AWF – JABAL SHAMS

Breakfast in hotel. After breakfast we drive to Wadi Bani Awf is one of the Arabia's greatest 4WD adventures and includes a visit to the village of Bilad Sait, a remote fortress village. Wadi Bani Awf also spelled Wadi

Bani AUF, is a large wadi in wilayat Al Rustaq in the South Batinah Governorate of Oman. The wadi covers a large area with several villages and lots of cool attractions worth visiting, including the famous Snake Canyon! The route through Wadi Bani AUF goes through beautiful scenery and connects all the way to Bilad Sayat in Al Dakhiliya region by crossing the Hajar Mountains and offers some of the best off road driving experience you can find in Oman. We visit the village of Al Hamra, famous for their old multi-storied mud houses surrounded by a vast expanse of lush green date plantations. We will also visit Misfah, a pretty village with stone houses, precariously clinging to the side of a huge mountain cliff. The village is laden with date, lemon and banana groves. Later Drive to Jabel Shams and Jabel Shams is the highest peak in the Gulf region. Enjoy breath taking view of the deep canyon. Overnight in Jabal Shams (Breakfast & Dinner)

DAY 04: JABAL SHAMS –HIKING - NIZWA

Breakfast in hotel. Check out from hotel and go for balcony walk, hiking around 3-4 hours. The Jabal Shams Balcony walk is a 4km hike with around 200m in elevation change. The hike takes around 3-4 hours depending on how many photos and food/drink break you take. Afternoon drive to Nizwa and visit the historic old city of Nizwa, home to an imposing 17th century fort and a bustling souq. visit Nizwa Fort, the 17th century round tower fort nearby is Oman's most impressive tower. Built on a solid base of rock, the huge tower was designed to withstand the vibrations of 24 cannons. From the top, a superb panoramic view gives visitors a bird's eye view all around Nizwa and the surrounding plains – a sure delight for all avid photographers. visit Nizwa Souq. The impressive New Souq complex has been sensitively designed using Omani fort architecture and elegant Islamic arches. The air-conditioned halls of this souq are full of fresh fruit and vegetables, herbs and spices, huge stacks of dates and freshly caught fish. This is still the best place to buy traditional silver "Khanjars" (hand- carved Omani daggers) and Bedouin jewellery, where silver is still sold by weight. Overnight stay in Nizwa (Breakfast)

DAY 05: JABREEN - BIRKAT AL MOUZ – JABAL AKHDAR

Breakfast in hotel. Drive to visit Jabreen. Jabreen Castle is the most beautiful historic castle in the whole of Oman. This historic castle was constructed in the late 17th century. Jabreen Castle is a palace constructed in times of peace by a ruler who was passionate about science and art and that made it the most beautiful historic castle found in the Sultanate. The castle is three stories tall, features two towers, numerous receptions halls, dining areas, meeting rooms, a court room, a library, and classrooms. The interior design of the castle features decorated windows, wooden balconies, arches with inscribed Arabic calligraphy, and breathtaking ceiling artwork. Later drive and village of Barkat Al Mauz. Enjoy a walk through the lush green date plantations. We continue to Jabal Akhdar (2000 meters above sea level) the green jewel of the Al Hajjar mountain ranges, a truly unique spot in the Arabian Peninsula. Enjoy the cool climate up in the mountains. Al Jabal Al Akhdar is famed for its fruit orchards typically laid out terrace style along the slopes of mountains, which are endowed with natural springs and aflaj. The villages of Saiq, Wadi Bani Habib (the

village of the old houses) & Al Ain dot the landscape. The villages overlook a spectacular landscape of dramatic peaks, gorges and wadis. The roses of Jabal Al Akhdar fill the air with fragrance when in full bloom (March / April). Rose water is distilled in the homes of the villagers. After the tour, check in at hotel. Overnight stay in Jabal Akhdar (Breakfast)

DAY 06: JABAL AKHDAR – TREKING

Breakfast in hotel. Jabal Akhdar Adventure wadi Hike. 5-6 Hours, Ideal for those looking for a leisurely exploration of nature and the villages at this mountain range, the Jabal Akhdar wadi Adventure walk will give an opportunity to explore numerous village and the natural wonders of Oman. Take in the great views offered by nature as you stroll through mountain trails crossing numerous villages, steep stairs hewn into the mountainside and across numerous Alfaj Irrigation systems which are part of the UNESCO World Heritage List. The village visits will help you develop a better understanding of the history, lives and workings of the Omani villages and their occupants and exploring the trails builds a greater appreciation for the rich variety of landscapes and natural flora and fauna available in Oman. After hiking, drive back to Hotel. Overnight stay in Jabal Akhdar (Breakfast)

DAY 07: JABAL AKHDAR – WAHIBA SANDS

Breakfast in hotel. Check out and Drive to Wahiba Sands. First we visit Sinaw Souq. Sinaw Souq features different areas for women and men, which are designated by a sign, but the action often spills out on to the streets, with sellers who missed out on a prime spot under the covered area opting to set up shop and display their wares along the pavement. Ibra is the second largest city in the Ash Sharqiyah Region of Oman. It is located about 170 km (2 hours) from Muscat and has a population estimated at 55,000 people. Ibra is one of the oldest cities in Oman and was once a center of trade, religion, education and art. The city acquired its importance as an important meeting point at the base of the Ash Sharqiya. Ibra is home of the huge Al-Harthy tribe, one of the biggest and most powerful tribes in Oman. The Al-Maskary tribe and the Al-Riyamy tribe are also both very prevalent in Ibra. Desert Safari over golden sand dunes and visit of a Bedouin family who live here amongst the woodland on the fringes of the sands. Sunset on nearby sand dunes. Overnight stay in a Desert Camp in Wahiba Sands (Breakfast & Dinner)

DAY 08: WAHIBA SANDS - WADI BANI KHALID - SUR

Breakfast in Camp, Depart to Wadi Bani Khalid and visit. Wadi Bani Khalid is considered one of the most beautiful wadi's in Oman. The drive to Wadi Bani Khalid is through the Eastern Hajar Mountains, which offers a panoramic view of landscape below. We pass many pretty villages embedded in the mountains. Here the road winds down to the wadi alongside a large, shallow pool fringed with vegetation and ends at a village. We park our vehicles at this point and continue on a short trek to the deep blue pools of the wadi. Enjoy a swim in this glorious grace of nature. Later drive to Sur. Sur the famous cities in the Persian Gulf

in building wooden ships. Its historical location gives it the hand to monitor the Gulf of Oman and the Indian Ocean. Many ships have been built in this city, like the sambuk and ghanjah they formerly went as far as China, India, Zanzibar, Iraq and many other countries. These vessels were also used in pearl fishing. Today the city has retained its reputation as a major. Dhow-building town, the very same vessels that were used for trade two centuries previously. Visit a Dhow Factory. Afternoon check in the Hotel. Dinner at the Hotel, after early dinner drive to Ras Al Jinz for a guided tour of Turtle watching. 45 Minutes' drive from Sur. Overnight stay in Sur / Ras al Hadd (Breakfast & Dinner)

DAY 09: SUR – WADI SHAB – SINKHOLE- MUSCAT

Breakfast in hotel. Drive to Muscat via beautiful Coastal road. First a stop at the ruins of Bibi Miriam's Tomb which can be seen at the village of Qalhat on coastal road to Muscat. Our next stop is Wadi Shab. Inside you will have to walk along palm groves, on rugged rocky cliffs and swim through some pools to get to the main attraction, which the submerged cave with waterfalls. It will take you about 30-45 minutes' walk to get to the cave and to enter it you have to swim through a hole between the mountains. Later visit Bimah Sinkhole, a spectacular limestone crater with blue green water at the bottom. On clear sunny days while driving along the coast one might chance to see sharks in the deep blue water or fleet footed Gazelle sprint across the landscape. Arrive Muscat after the tour. Overnight stay in Muscat (Breakfast)

DAY 10: DEPARTURE TRANSFER

Breakfast in hotel. Today after check out from the hotel you will be dropped off to Muscat International Airport.
