DAY 01: QUITO

Welcome to Ecuador! Upon arrival at the international airport, you will be warmly greeted by our staff, who will assist you with the transfer to your hotel. The drive takes approximately one hour, allowing you to enjoy panoramic views of the Andean landscape on your way to the city. You will stay at Hotel Finlandia 4* (www.hotelfinlandiaquito.com), a comfortable and modern hotel offering the perfect base for your Quito adventures.

DAY 02: CITY TOUR – “MITAD DEL MUNDO” (EQUATOR LINE)

After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you'll embark on an exciting city tour of Quito — a city rich in history and culture. This excursion is a perfect opportunity to admire the breathtaking panoramas, historical churches, and beautifully decorated rooftops while learning about the colonial art and architecture that define this vibrant capital. Founded in the 16th century on the ruins of an Inca city, Quito sits at an altitude of 2,850 meters. Despite the devastating 1917 earthquake, it still preserves the best-maintained historic center in Latin America. As you explore, you'll encounter exquisite architecture and ornate interiors showcasing the unique Quito School of Art — a fusion of Spanish, Italian, Moorish, Flemish, and Indigenous influences. After four fascinating hours in the Old Town, you'll understand why Quito was the first city in the world to be declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In the afternoon, your adventure continues with a visit to the Ciudad Mitad del Mundo and Intiñan Museum. At Ciudad Mitad del Mundo, you'll discover an engaging blend of tourism, culture, and science. The iconic Equator Monument marks the middle of the Earth at 0° latitude. Surrounded by beautiful colonial-style architecture and dramatic landscapes, the site invites you to learn about Ecuador's geographical significance. The monument is crowned with a metallic globe representing Earth — a striking visual centerpiece of this unique site. Next, visit the Intiñan Museum, which since 1960 has celebrated Ecuador's rich cultural heritage. This interactive museum offers fascinating exhibits showing how the Incas determined the location of the equator and includes fun scientific experiments — such as balancing an egg on a nail! This hands-on experience provides a memorable and educational insight into the wonders of the equatorial line. After a day full of discovery, return to Hotel Finlandia 4* to relax and reflect on your experiences in Quito.

DAY 03: MINDO

After breakfast at the hotel, set out on a journey to Mindo, a charming town nestled in one of Ecuador's most scenic regions. Known for its stunning natural beauty and rich biodiversity, Mindo attracts both nature lovers and adventure seekers. Your first stop is a butterfly farm, where you can admire delicate butterflies fluttering among a dazzling variety of orchids and vibrant hummingbirds. Mindo is home to over 500 bird species and 400 species of orchids, making it a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts. Next, experience the thrill of crossing the forest canopy on a cable car, suspended about 30 meters above the ground. This unique vantage point allows you to fully appreciate the lush landscape below. Afterward, enjoy a leisurely walk through the forest, immersing yourself in the sights and sounds of this biodiverse ecosystem. For the adventurous, Mindo offers zip-lining opportunities — an exhilarating ride between canopy towers with spectacular views and an unforgettable adrenaline rush. To conclude the day, take part in a chocolate tour, where you'll witness the fascinating bean-to-bar process. This immersive experience not only delights your taste buds but also deepens your appreciation of chocolate's cultural significance in Ecuador. After a day full of nature and excitement, return to Hotel Finlandia 4* for a relaxing evening. (Meals: Breakfast)

DAY 04: QUILOTOA

After breakfast, depart for a scenic drive to the breathtaking Quilotoa Crater Lake. On the way, stop at a Tigua art workshop, where you'll admire vibrant local paintings that capture the essence of Andean life. The colorful and distinctive Tigua folk art reflects the region's rich cultural heritage. Upon arrival at Quilotoa Loop, you'll be greeted by the mesmerizing view of an emerald-green lake nestled within a volcanic crater surrounded by steep, jagged cliffs — a truly unforgettable sight. Enjoy a hike down to the lake shore to fully take in the beauty and tranquility of this natural wonder. For the return ascent, you may choose to ride a mule, adding a touch of adventure to your experience. Alternatively, for those seeking even more excitement, kayaking on the lake offers a unique perspective of the stunning surroundings. After a day of exploration and natural beauty, return to Hotel Finlandia 4* for a peaceful evening. (Meals: Breakfast) Stops include: a rose plantation, scenic viewpoints, an indigenous art gallery, and the crater lake.
